ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Regular attendance of Mass is a full part of preparing for First Communion and so we expect the families of all children in the programme to attend Mass every Saturday evening or Sunday with their children. If you regularly and intentionally fail to attend Mass you may be asked to delay your child's First Holy Communion.

We run a **Parent-Child Programme**. This means that Parents will be required to attend a number of sessions alongside their children. During those sessions, we would expect Parents to participate fully and cooperate with us as we journey together towards First Confession and Holy Communion.

Parents and their children are required to attend ALL the preparation meetings. The first meeting covers important information about the programme; the remaining meetings will prepare your child to receive First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion and help you to communicate the faith to your child.

Families having difficulties with the schedule of Sessions should discuss this with the Catechetical Coordinator or the Parish Priest at the earliest opportunity.

Missed Sessions. Parents and children should attend all sessions. If more than two sessions are missed from the programme, your child's communion will be deferred to the following year when you will have more time to commit to the process. Registers of attendance will be kept to help us with this decision. We prefer to be informed about absences prior to the event rather than after.

The dates of the programme and ceremony will be confirmed at the earliest opportunity.

Another date may be set at a later stage for the Presentation of Certificates. It would be good if all children and their families could attend this.

First Confession normally takes place during Lent. All children must attend their First Confession before they can make their First Holy Communion. We encourage Parents to consider making their child's First Confession a family celebration by approaching the Sacrament themselves and with other family members who might wish to join as well.

ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

Incomplete applications cannot be processed
Late forms will not be accepted
Children must be in Year 3 and 7 years old at least
Our programme has limited capacity

If we receive applications above the capacity, the following will apply:

First - Children/families attending Saturday evening/Sunday Mass at St Mary's Cadogan Street

Second - Children of Registered Parishioners

Third - Children of families living within the parish boundary

Like other parishes St Mary's relies on committed volunteers to be catechists and helpers on our First Holy Communion programme and we always need and appreciate more help; without your help numbers on this programme may have to be severely restricted or it may not prove possible to run at all.
