The word “holiday” comes from the Old English “haligdaeg,” which simply combined “halig” (“holy”) and “daeg” (“day”) into one word. But “haligdaeg” was both “a consecrated day or religious festival” and “a day on which ordinary activities and work are suspended; a day of festivities,” i.e., a largely secular day off.

Over these next weeks many of our parishioners will take a well-deserved break. The nature of our parish means that people will return to their home countries to visit family and friends. For some it will be the first time they have been out of the country for a number of years because of the pandemic.

In the parish the pace of life is a little less frenetic. There will be a simpler style of liturgy, short homilies and no music—quite a relief when the temperature is hitting over 30 degrees! There will be one newsletter for August. Please note that during this holiday period the times of week day Mass may change to accommodate the supply priests who are covering for Fr Shaun, but we will give plenty of notice.

We also have a volunteer system for ministry so please sign up to read, welcome or act as a minister of the Eucharist if that is a function you normally perform.

We hope you have a restful time over these next weeks. We will resume our full raft of activities from the first week of September. On September the 11th we will have our famous Pizza and Prosecco welcome back party. We provide fresh delicious wood fired pizzas and you provide prosecco, wine or soft drinks. This year the party will have a special significance as it will be Fr Shaun's 60th birthday in September !
